Food from the Heart will make its debut on May 2 at The Food Truck Stop at 801 S. Chester from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. in Little Rock. Chef Coby Smith will serve ramen that day.

“Food from the Heart will have multiple popup locations. Allowing us to reach our friends outside of the metro in communities where our clinics are located. When disaster strikes it will also be utilized to help feed affected areas.” Atwood said.
