MICHAEL LOGUIDICE MD ELECTROPHYSIOLOGY

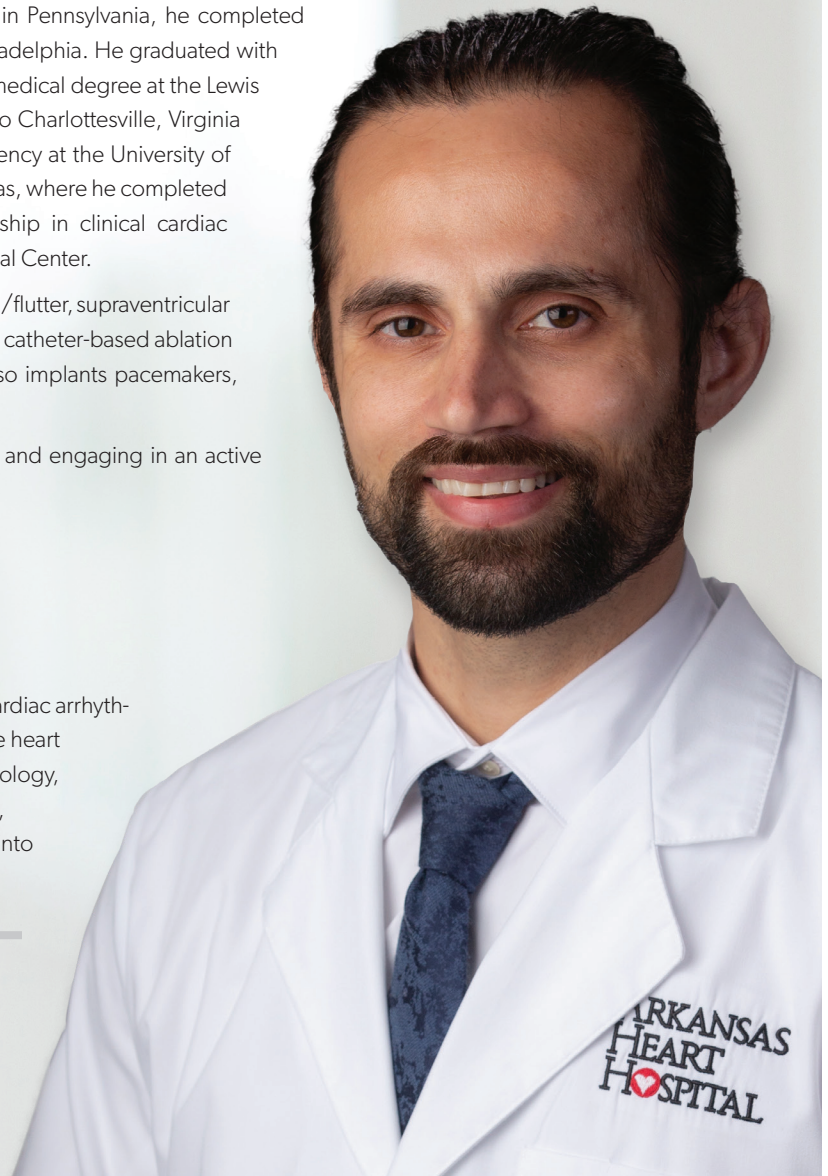
Michael Loguidice is an electrophysiologist, board-certified in cardiovascular disease, clinical cardiac electrophysiology and internal medicine. Growing up in Pennsylvania, he completed both his undergraduate coursework and medical degree in Philadelphia. He graduated with honors from the University of Pennsylvania before receiving his medical degree at the Lewis Katz School of Medicine at Temple University. He then moved to Charlottesville, Virginia where he completed his internal medicine internship and residency at the University of Virginia Medical Center. After residency, he moved to Dallas, Texas, where he completed both his general cardiology fellowship and advanced fellowship in clinical cardiac electrophysiology at the University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center.

Dr. Loguidice treats heart rhythm disorders such as atrial fibrillation/flutter, supraventricular tachycardia and ventricular tachycardia with simple and complex catheter-based ablation therapy, cardioversions and anti-arrhythmic medications. He also implants pacemakers, defibrillators and other devices.

In his free time, he enjoys playing his guitar, seeing live music, and engaging in an active lifestyle through hiking, running, kayaking and yoga.
