He is a fellow in the American College of Cardiology and the European Society of Cardiology and has published 130 manuscripts and 34 papers in peer-reviewed cardiology journals. In addition, Dr. Ribeiro has published seven book chapters, including one in Dr. Eric Topol's "Textbook of Interventional Cardiology". He has been a reviewer for the Journal of the American College of Cardiology, British Heart Journal, American Journal of Cardiology and European Heart Journal.
